Built in 1904, this two-story English Arts and Crafts house is situated on a level 4.27-acre property with rolling lawns and stunning panoramic views. A stone pergola covered by ancient wisteria, a screened porch, an inviting fire pit and extensive antique stone work and tiered terraces offer multiple location environments.

This gorgeously restored historic home features original period details, hardwood floors throughout, and three massive stone wood burning fireplaces. The grand two-story foyer with an open staircase is highlighted with arched hallways. The grand living room features large blown glass windows, a fieldstone fireplace, a grand piano, and a custom Dieter Rams bookshelf. The family room offers custom built-in oak bookshelves and moldings, and another large stone fireplace.

A three-season room features a third stone fireplace facing a wall of glass French doors with a view of spectacular sunrises in the east, adjacent to the expansive screened porch from where you can watch sunsets in the west. The bright spacious dining room overlooks the gardens and a mature magnolia and cherry tree through a bank of large windows. The gourmet kitchen features custom cabinetry, antique farm table island, professional appliances and the butler's pantry with original drainboards and cupboards.
