The magnificent wood carvings for the interior of the church inspired by Thistle chapel in Scotland, were installed in 1923.

Great Lawn: A 2 acre expanse of gently sloped grass with access to electrical power and the street. Tents are permitted

Cloister: An intimate, enclosed courtyard with walkway and direct access to the church and Parish Hall.

Barn: A charming old horse barn with hay loft, which has been outfitted as a Church Thrift Shop.

Parish Hall: Beautiful woodworking and stained glass windows surround this historic space with large stone fireplace, private entrance and private bathroom. Can hold up to 80 people

Pipe Organ: installed in the 1920s, The exquisite organ case, also dating from the 1920s, was meticulously preserved and restored, with new lighting.
