Meticulously restored jewel box three-story Queen Anne townhouse overlooking the Hudson River.

Built in 1885, this brick Victorian home has all of its original architectural details intact. Hardwood floors throughout, black walnut woodwork, 4 fireplaces, working pocket doors and stained-glass windows are just a few. The home features a range of iconic vintage, antique, and contemporary designs as well as uniquely appointed art.

This 4 bedroom home has 11 finished rooms on the 2 main living floors with 4 rooms on the partially finished 3rd floor. 11-foot ceilings enhance the feeling of open space and windows on every wall flood the home with natural light.

The back porch is 2 stories with access from Savannah windows on both levels, overlooking a fenced back yard and views of the Hudson River.
