Fully renovated and restored historic townhome overlooking Cobble Hill Park, spanning 4500 square feet over 6 fully finished floors.

The original staircase spirals through all floors, surrounded by the original, ornate plaster crown moldings and white oak floors.

1st FLOOR: Sitting Room with ventless fireplace and arched window overlooking the park; Kitchen/Dining Room with full glass wall opening up to back porch. Kitchen is white oak cabinets with pops of orange/red throughout and features custom glass knobs and Calacatta marble counters and backsplash. The porch steps lead down into a grassy backyard with a cedar fence.

2nd FLOOR: Layout original to the house with original wood pocket doors. White oak herringbone parquet floors with walnut inlays. Round Piano Nobile with powder room; Front- Formal Living Room with wood-burning fireplace and large windows overlooking the park. The windows have their original pocket shutters. Back- Family Room w/large glass wall overlooking the backyard. Original non-working fireplace and wall of white oak built-ins with vibrant orange/red interior. Mini bar behind flush door.

3rd FLOOR: Primary bedroom suite. Double pocket doors open up to a custom white oak closet. Large bedroom in the back. Small office/nursery with ventless fireplace in front. Marble and soothing green bathroom with a large window in front.

4th FLOOR: Front- Baby Room. **This room is an active baby room. Back- Guest Bedroom; Full Bathroom; Laundry Room.

5th FLOOR: Office Suite (could also be a family room) with white wash cabinetry. Kitchenette with extra large skylight and glass floor looking down into spiral staircase.

Large roof deck overlooking treetops with wood-burning outdoor fireplace. *Fireplace now has an arched opening that is missing in the photos.

GARDEN: Mudroom; Workshop; Laundry Room; Full Bathroom; Bedroom with glass wall opening up to the sunken patio. The bench in this patio lights up at night through vintage-colored glass
