Tucked away among tall trees and sweeping lawns in Scotch Plains, New Jersey, this light-filled, two-level single-family home is a striking example of mid-century modern design. Thoughtfully designed by interior designer Luke Foss, the residence celebrates its original character while offering a warm, geometric, and highly cinematic atmosphere.

Original beam ceilings and mosaic tile floors anchor the home's mid-century roots, while intentional color blocking and carefully composed sightlines create visual interest from nearly every angle. The living room centers around a fireplace and is bathed in natural light throughout the day, enhanced by beautifully framed windows that draw the outdoors in. Stonework walls and rich wood paneling add texture and warmth, giving the space a cozy yet elevated feel.

The kitchen and dining nook feature hardwood floors and flow seamlessly into a dedicated dining room, making the layout both functional and visually dynamic. A striking skylight effect runs along the main hallway leading to the bedrooms, casting soft, architectural light and adding depth to the interior experience.

Downstairs, the home opens into a media room and secondary living space with direct access to the outdoors, offering flexibility for relaxation or production use. A generous rear balcony extends the living area outside, while the two-car garage and driveway provide easy load-in and load-out.

Throughout the home, unique paintings owned by the family lend character and charm.
