Exterior is white on white and has a full porch with 10 colums across front. there is a stone patio across the full back of house. The property is 9 acres and has a stream, an orchard, 2 red barns and stone and timber bar.

Partially built in 1790's and added to in early to mid 1800, the house was the home of a prosperous farmer and has some exceptional details, winding staircase, large moldings, floor to ceiling windows, arched pocket doors. Original architectural details of the house with modern twist - pickled floors, spare furnishings, lots of french doors and tons of light. The wall colors are whites, sophisticated neutrals, and a few surprise blasts of color discretely placed.

All the rooms on the first floor are large, sitting room, dining room, kitchen (approx 21×27), powder room and entrance hall. Kitchen has stainless steel cabinetry and appliances. Second floor has master bedroom with fireplace, dressing room and big master bath, guest room and second bath, and a wing that isn't finished yet.
